



Questions to Ask University Admissions Representatives

Important Note: If you are a Running Start or International student, please be sure to share this information with the Admissions Representative so that you can be advised appropriately.

Admissions

- What are the admission requirements? Do I need a minimum GPA or credits to apply?
- What is the priority deadline for applying to your college? Is there also a separate application and deadline for applying to my major?
- Once I submit my application, when can I expect to hear back from your school?

Majors

- What is the GPA required for my major?
- If I am undecided on a major, how will this affect my admission? Once enrolled at your school, when do I have to declare a major? Do you have advising services/resources for undecided students?
- Do I have to submit a portfolio of my work or have an audition? (This may be required if you are trying to apply to majors such as art, architecture, music and a few other areas of study)

College Costs

- What are the costs of tuition, fees, housing, parking, etc? When do I pay those fees?
- Do I have to send in a deposit to confirm my intention to enroll? How much? When?

Financial Aid & Scholarships

- What types of financial aid and scholarships are available? Is there a separate application required for scholarships?
- What is your priority deadline for financial aid and scholarships?
- Do you have any scholarships, grants, WUE, etc. for non-residents? (Ask this question if the transfer institution is out-of-state)

Classroom & Resources

- How big is your school? What is a typical class size?
- What clubs and organizations exist on your campus? Do you have a recreation center?
- Do you have a tutoring center, TRiO program, career center, etc.?

- Who is the contact person for transfer students at your college?
- How can I arrange a campus tour or visit?
