I. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

A. College

- 1. Approves curriculum within course outlines.
- 2. Separates faculty evaluation from a faculty member's personal beliefs or statements in their personal life.
- 3. Determines institutional policies and procedures.

B. Faculty

- 1. Determines and delivers approved content from course outlines.
- 2. Determines and practices the best pedagogy for course content.
- 3. Clearly identifies when speaking/writing as a faculty member versus a community member.
- 4. Engages in civic and community discourse while being mindful of the importance of free inquiry.

C. Student

- 1. Engages in learning by following course guidelines and course content.
- 2. Expresses diverse perspectives within the guidelines of debate or discussion, generally expected in a classroom.
- 3. Receives equal academic treatment by faculty regardless of diverse expression.
- 4. Receives protection of improper disclosures of views, beliefs, and political opinions shared in professional interactions with faculty.
