4210	Anderson, J.	Required	Pencils and other supplies discussed in class.
4211 4212 4213	Anderson, J.	Required	Pencils and other supplies discussed in class.
4507	Barer, D.	Required	Treat Pouch. High Value treats (something your dog really likes!). No retractable leashes. Proof of current vaccinations required.
4506	Barer, S.	Required	Dog Mat (can be a bath mat/rug/towel). Head Harness (Gentle Leader or Halti). No choke chains or prong collars. Short lead leash. A clicker for training. Treats. Proof of current vaccinations required. Dogs should stay in their cars until escorted to proper training spot by instructors.
3710	Biggs, D.	Suggested	Students do not have to have a camera to learn about photography but are encouraged to bring their own camera. Any camera format is okay but the class will have an emphasis on digital photography.
3722 3723	Carson, B	Required	Passport (required!), water bottle, camera, binoculars, daypack, lunch for the day, rain gear (top and bottom), waterproof boots, all-weather clothes, sun protection, insect repellent, swimsuit, money for meals and other purchases.

3719 3720	Carson, B	Required	Water bottle, waterproof camera with a wristband (will attach to life jacket so won't get dropped), waterproof bags (some dry bags are available, but not completely waterproof), boat shoes (something that straps on and will not fall off, preferably not boots), sun protection (sunscreen, hat with a tie, dark sunglasses with a tie), lightweight waterproof jacket (raingear top) in case you want to put it over your wetsuit, towel and change of clothes.
4509	Chryst, J.	Required	Current vaccines proof, leash, and collar or harness.
4203	Dewitt, V.	Required	Student should already have a kevlar (or similar) glove and an understanding of carving safety techniques, sharpening techniques, and blade edge maintenance. A familiarity with wood grain characteristics will also help the student during the carving process. A method of clamping or holding the wood blank such as a square of gripping shelf liner material and/or a bench hook will be required to improve safety. A selection of knives and gouges will be required. The instructor will make a power sharpener available during each class for supervised use by the student.
