Respondus LockDown Browser uses a standard Windows or Mac installer that can be downloaded by faculty or students from the following link (note: this link is unique for WWCC and should only be used for personal computers, not institution-owned computers):

The short version instructions are this:

- Open the designated quiz in Canvas
- At the initial screen, the student will be prompted to download the app (it works for Windows or Mac computers— but not most Chromebooks or cell phones).
- Once the app is installed, an icon will appear on the computer monitor entitled “LockDown Browser” and it is shaped like a globe with a padlock on it.
- The student should then close out of all applications and web browsers, click on the icon and they will be directed to the Canvas quiz
- (NOTE: Students **should not** go to their Start menu and type “Respondus” or “LockDown” in that because it does not go to the Canvas quiz; instead, it just opens the executable application and is not going to get students into the requisite quiz.)

Look for the opportunity to practice using the LockDown browser prior to taking a high value test.
