

# 2022/2023 FINANCIAL AID CONSIDERATION

Students at WWCC whose FAFSA applications have been received by the federal processor as of March 1, 2022 and have a completed financial aid file\* by May 2, 2022 will be given priority consideration for financial aid funds.

## Checklist for Financial Aid Consideration:

- A submitted and processed **2022/2023** Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) that lists Walla Walla Community College in the school section of the application. The FAFSA can be submitted at [www.studentaid.gov](http://www.studentaid.gov). WWCC's school code is 005006.
- WWCC Financial Aid Information Form for the **2022/2023** school year
- If FAFSA selects you for verification**, you will be required to submit additional documentation. **You can view any outstanding items on your Financial Aid Portal** ([www.wbcc.edu/fportal](http://www.wbcc.edu/fportal)).

*\*Once the above items are completed, your financial aid file will move forward to the review process*

## Additional information that may be required:

- Direct Loan borrowers only:**
  - Items must be completed either for WWCC or another college
  - ✓ Master Promissory Note ([www.studentaid.gov](http://www.studentaid.gov))
  - ✓ Loan Entrance Counseling ([www.studentaid.gov](http://www.studentaid.gov))
  - ✓ Annual Student Loan Acknowledgement ([www.studentaid.gov](http://www.studentaid.gov))
  - ✓ An official loan request – on the back of the WWCC Information Form
  - ✓ An additional/late loan request can be submitted. Forms are available at the Financial Aid Office. Additional/late requests will be processed at a later date.
- For all new students:**
  - ✓ WWCC Admission Application submitted to the Office of Admissions
- For all transfer students:**
  - ✓ Official Transcripts from all previously attended colleges or universities submitted to the Office of Admissions.

## Checklist for DREAMers & DACA students (students not eligible to file a FAFSA):

*For non-citizen students who meet the Washington State Need Grant program's income and residency requirements.*

- A submitted and processed **2022/2023** Washington Application for State Financial Aid (WASFA) that lists Walla Walla Community College in the school section of the application. The WASFA can be submitted at <https://wsac.wa.gov/wasfa>. (Application deadline: May 2, 2022)
- WWCC Financial Aid Information Form for the **2022/2023** school year (Deadline: May 2, 2022)

## Additional information that may be required:

- For all new students:**
  - ✓ Signed Washington Higher Education Residency Affidavit/Declaration/Certification (WSAC Form HB 1079) submitted to the Office of Admissions
- For all transfer students:**
  - ✓ Official Transcripts from all previously attended colleges or universities submitted to the Office of Admissions.
