

Placement Testing Procedure

To access placement testing, students **must** complete the following steps before testing:

- 1) Apply to Walla Walla Community College
- 2) Once accepted, complete the New Student Entry Portal and activate your NET ID
<https://www.wwcc.edu/getting-started/>
 - a. Upload any documents you have for placement (unofficial transcript, SBAC, ACT/SAT))
 - b. If you have nothing to upload, select “nothing to upload” (we can look at complete HS transcripts at the end of the year once Math courses are completed)

Placement Testing can be either remote OR in person on campus with Covid-19 protocols in place.

To access **remote placement testing** students **will need**:

- 1) Computer/Laptop
- 2) Webcam and Mic
- 3) Reliable internet

To schedule a placement test for Running Start:

- 1) Email our testing center at testing@wwcc.edu, request a Running Start Placement, and the mode of testing you prefer. (Remote or on campus)
- 2) Work with the testing center to schedule an appointment to test for Math, English, and Reading
- 3) Take the placement test from a remote location (plan for 1.5-2hrs)
- 4) Test Result/What to do next:

a. College Level English (English 101), College Level Reading Placement, and any Math: i. Email your HS counselor for Running Start paperwork (provide a good phone number for your HS counselor to contact you back)

b. English CAP/87/97 OR Read CAP/88 Placement and any Math: i. Please email warrioradvising@wwcc.edu (Walla Walla Campus) or clarkston.warrioradvising@wwcc.edu (Clarkston campus) for a follow up appointment before contacting your HS counselor in regards about placement results

Your test results will be emailed to your WWCC Student email account shortly after you complete the test. A WWCC staff member will email you will next step instructions
