

## **Diplomas, Degrees and Certificates**

- 362 Academic Transfer Degrees
- 348 Workforce Degrees
- 455 One Year or More Certificates
- 495 One Year or Less Certificates
- 94 High School Diplomas or GEDs
- 1,754 Total Diplomas, Degrees and Certificates
- **49%** of full-time students graduate or transfer within three years; higher than the average of our peer institutions.
- **42%** of full-time students of color graduated or transferred within three years.

Within One Year of Graduating:

- **53%** of Academic Transfer graduates transferred to a four-year school.
- **79%** of Workforce degree- or certificate-earning graduates were estimated employed.
