HUMANITIES	None	A minimum of 15 credits from 3 different subject areas including one literature course.
SOCIAL SCIENCES	Phys&100-General Psychology	15 total credits from three different subject areas required. Sociology 101 is highly recommended for a major in nursing.**
QUANTITATIVE SKILLS	Math201-Statistics	No additional requirements.
NATURAL SCIENCE	Chem&110-Chemical Concepts Biol&160-General Biology Nutr&10-1-Nutrition	No additional requirements.
PHYSICAL EDUCATION	None	Three unduplicated activity courses required.
ELECTIVES	Biol&251-Anatomy & Physiology I Biol&252-Anatomy & Physiology II Biol&260-Microbiology Psc&200&200-Lifespan Psychology	A minimum of 24 credits are required. After completing all nursing pre-requisites, 4 additional credits are required. This may be satisfied by nursing courses.
DIVERSITY	None	One course designated as D^. Sociology 101 fulfills this requirement. Other diversity courses are distributed throughout the General Education categories and are double designated with distribution requirements.
