## QUESTIONS FOR STUDENT RENTERS TO THINK ABOUT BEFORE RENTING:

## Rent and Utilities

$\Rightarrow$ How much is the monthly rent? When is the rent due?
$\Rightarrow$ Does the rent include heat, water and gas? How much do utilities typically cost per month?
$\Rightarrow$ Is the apartment furnished? Is there an option to pay more to get furniture?
$\Rightarrow$ Are there hook-up fees you will have to pay?
$\Rightarrow$ Are garages, parking and storage spaces included?
$\Rightarrow$ What about appliances (dishwasher, disposal, etc.)?
$\Rightarrow$ Where are the laundry facilities? Do they cost extra?

## Roommates

$\Rightarrow$ If you have roommates, are you each responsible for your own share of the rent, or will you be expected to cover costs if one of the roommates doesn't pay?
$\Rightarrow$ Will you each have a specific bill to pay on top of rent? Ex: heat, water, gas
$\Rightarrow$ If the apartment is unfurnished, which roommate will supply what furniture?
$\Rightarrow$ Does each roommate sign the lease?

## Leases

A lease is a binding contract. You should be familiar with the terms of your lease and what the law requires of you and your landlord to avoid problems. Fail to abide by the terms of your lease and you'll form a bad tenant history which will make it difficult to rent in the future.
$\Rightarrow$ Is the lease for an academic or a calendar year?
$\Rightarrow$ If it's a 12-month contract, can you sublet the apartment in the summer if necessary?
$\Rightarrow$ Are there extra fees for additional roommates?
$\Rightarrow$ What happens if you break the lease? Is there a fine?
$\Rightarrow$ Are pets allowed?

## Security Deposit

You will probably have to pay the landlord a security deposit, which will be used to pay for damages to the apartment when you move out. Usually your landlord will have to provide a list of damages, the repairs needed to fix them, and written evidence, such as invoices or bills, indicating the costs. If repair expenses exceed your security deposit, your landlord can sue you for the additional costs. Your landlord must return the balance of the deposit once all repairs have been made.
$\Rightarrow$ How much is the security deposit? When will you get your deposit back?
$\Rightarrow$ As the tenant, what do you need to do to make sure that you get back your entire deposit?
$\Rightarrow$ Is there an additional deposit for keys or pets?
