COVID-19 Safety Training

Employees and students will adhere to all rules and protocols stated in the WWCC plan, including daily attendance and health status checks.

Social Distancing

Employees and students will adhere to all rules and protocols stated in the WWCC plan. Program specific practices will include:

- Students will occupy every other booth, with booths being assigned to students prior to lab entry; unused booths will be barricaded

- Floor warning tape designating 6-foot distances will be placed around work stations and pathways
- Inspection area will use a clear plastic barrier to allow closer but separated student and instructor review of work samples
- Filler materials will be dispensed by the instructor at the beginning of class; containers used will be filled and delivered to the lab booth area where students are working

Personal Protective Equipment – Employer/Training Program Provided

Employees and students will adhere to all rules and protocols stated in the WWCC plan. Program specific practices will include:

- Appropriate welding work attire will include hard leather work boots, safety glasses, face shield and a respirator
- Any time a student is not wearing a welding face shield (during inspections, restroom breaks, etc.) they must instead wear a disposable or reusable face covering
