Walla Walla Community College will be opening for Fall 2020 under Warrior Flex. Warrior Flex calls for all curriculum that can be taught virtually to continue to be taught virtually. Programs with required hands-on learning will be allowed to have students and faculty access campus for hands-on components. The majority of student services departments will operate remotely. Screening	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ IF YOU ARE SICK, PLEASE STAY HOME ❖ All employees and students will complete the daily screening log prior to, or upon entrance to the campus to check in and confirm that they are symptom free. ❖ The daily screening log will also be used to assist with contact tracing in the event of a COVID-19 positive case.
Reporting	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ If you develop symptoms, stay home, contact your health care provider and notify your supervisor or instructor.
Physical Distancing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ WWCC has made facility modifications to ensure 6 feet of physical distancing happens while on campus. You will see posted signs for physical distancing, floor decal reminders, plexiglas barriers at service counters and modifications to classrooms and common areas.
Face Coverings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Face coverings are mandatory on campus at all times except when eating or drinking. ❖ Students with disabilities requesting an accommodation should contact bobbiesue.schutter@wwcc.edu for the Walla Walla campus or heather.markwalter@wwcc.edu for the Clarkston campus. ❖ Employees with disabilities requesting an accommodation should contact the WWCC Human Resources office at HR@wwcc.edu.
Hygiene, Cleaning and Disinfecting	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Wash hands frequently and for at least 20 seconds ❖ Use hand sanitizer and avoid touching surfaces. ❖ Keep a clean work or class space by regularly disinfecting and cleaning. ❖ High traffic areas will be routinely cleaned and disinfected by custodial staff throughout the day.
Communicate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ WWCC will provide information on multiple channels including the College's COVID-19 webpage, Canvas, social media and the College email system.
Training	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ All employees and students must complete WWCC's safety training prior to accessing campus.
