ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY 6200**

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**I. POLICY BACKGROUND/PURPOSE**

Walla Walla Community College (WWCC) values students' academic achievement and celebrates their educational success. This policy intends to support students in promoting successful learning and will serve as a mechanism to notify students when corrective steps are necessary to maintain enrollment at the College. This policy complies with the accreditation requirements of the [Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities](#) (NWCCU) to achieve student learning success.

**II. AUTHORITY**

Board of Trustees Policy 1500-Delegation of Authority, [RCW 28B.50.140 \(13\)](#), NWCCU.

**III. SCOPE OF POLICY**

This policy applies to all enrolled students.

**IV. POLICY**

- A. Students meeting the following conditions are recognized for their academic achievement for honors while enrolled at WWCC:
  - 1. Enrolled full-time (12 or more credits), and
  - 2. Pursuing an associate degree or certificate.
  - 3. Exclusions include:
    - a. Remedial courses
    - b. Cooperative work experience credits
- B. Students will be notified by the Office of Admission and Records (OAR) regarding academic performance in relationship to remediation if:
  - 1. Pursuing an associate degree or certificate, and
  - 2. 10 or more credits are attempted
