WALLA WALLA COMMUNITY COLLEGE ACADEMIC STANDING ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY 6200

I. POLICY BACKGROUND/PURPOSE

Walla Walla Community College (WWCC) values students' academic achievement and celebrates their educational success. This policy intends to support students in promoting successful learning and will serve as a mechanism to notify students when corrective steps are necessary to maintain enrollment at the College. This policy complies with the accreditation requirements of the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities (NWCCU) to achieve student learning success.

II. AUTHORITY

Board of Trustees Policy 1500-Delegation of Authority, RCW 28B.50.140 (13), NWCCU.

III. SCOPE OF POLICY

This policy applies to all enrolled students.

IV. POLICY

- A. Students meeting the following conditions are recognized for their academic achievement for honors while enrolled at WWCC:
 - 1. Enrolled full-time (12 or more credits), and
 - 2. Pursuing an associate degree or certificate.
 - 3. Exclusions include:
 - a. Remedial courses
 - b. Cooperative work experience credits
- B. Students will be notified by the Office of Admission and Records (OAR) regarding academic performance in relationship to remediation if:
 - 1. Pursuing an associate degree or certificate, and
 - 2. 10 or more credits are attempted
