The combination of in-person and online instructional components meets the established equivalent for the credit hours designated. All hybrid classes are supported through use of the College's Learning Management System. Remote proctored exams are an allowable activity for this classification. EXAMPLES: ✓ Online class with no set ti	Online classes that are unscheduled. Sessions are not held at specific times, but learning is structured to take place over the duration of the class and is not self-paced. The online instructional components meet the established equivalent for the credit hours designated.
