P	In Person	A face-to-face class with scheduled meeting times which does not require the use of web-based tools.	<p>Students and instructors meet for a certain number of hours in-person at regularly scheduled times based on the credit hours designated.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Canvas is not used for these courses.</li> <li>• Eligible for P: AHSE 022, AHSE 051, AHSE 104, all ECPE</li> </ul>	None	"This class meets in person; see schedule for class meeting days/times/location."
		<p><b>EXAMPLES:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ 3-hour OTEP class scheduled on a single night, off campus</li> <li>✓ 6-hour CPR class scheduled over two days in a classroom/lab on campus.</li> </ul>			
WE	In-Person (Web-Enhanced)	A face-to-face class with scheduled meeting times which requires the use of web-based tools.	<p>Students and instructors meet for a certain number of hours in-person at regularly scheduled times based on the credit hours designated. All web-enhanced courses are supported through use of the College's Learning Management System.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Canvas is used in these courses for posting syllabi, gradebook, announcements, resources, discussion posts, homework submission, etc.</li> <li>• All instructional hours are scheduled in a classroom/lab.</li> </ul>	\$25	"This class meets in person, uses Canvas, and requires reliable access to the internet. See schedule for class meeting days/times/location."
		<p><b>EXAMPLES:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Daily lectures on-campus in a classroom</li> <li>✓ Three one-hour lectures and a two-hour lab all scheduled on campus in classrooms/labs</li> </ul>			

HY	Hybrid	<p><i>A class that displaces some, but not all face-to-face instruction time with web-based tools.</i></p> <p><i>On-site or remotely-proctored exams are allowed for this classification.</i></p>	<p><i>Hybrid classes combine in-person and online instruction. Students and instructors meet on campus at regularly scheduled times but many class activities are conducted online, including class work assignments, discussions, and group projects.</i></p> <p><i>The combination of in-person and online instructional components meets the established equivalent for the credit hours designated.</i></p> <p><i>All hybrid classes are supported through use of the College's Learning Management System.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hybrid = a combination of in-person instructional hours and instruction delivered online, whether synchronous or asynchronous.</li> </ul>	\$25	<p><i>"Students attend class in person with some instruction delivered online through Canvas. Some online meetings may be held on Zoom. Reliable internet access required. See schedule for class meeting days/times/location."</i></p>
		<p><b>EXAMPLES:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Online Zoom lectures with on-campus labs.</li> <li>✓ Two or three on-campus lectures per week with the remainder of instruction delivered online.</li> <li>✓ Weekly on-campus labs, one weekly scheduled Zoom meeting, with additional online instructional activities.</li> </ul>			

FL	Flexible	<p>A class in which the student can choose to attend face-to-face or take the class using a mix of online scheduled or online asynchronous. Students may switch between modes throughout the term.</p> <p>The class must include at least one of the following instruction mode combinations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In-person and online asynchronous</li> <li>• In-person and online scheduled</li> <li>• In-person, online scheduled, and online asynchronous</li> </ul> <p><b>The exact mix of modes must be included in the class notes.</b></p>	<p>Flexible classes allow the student to choose to attend class in person and/or online.</p> <p>The class must include at least one of the following instruction mode combinations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>In-person and online asynchronous:</b> In-person class meetings are held at regularly scheduled times. Students also may participate in the class asynchronously online, with recordings and other instructor-guided activities.</li> <li>• <b>In-person and online scheduled:</b> In-person and online class meetings are held synchronously at regularly scheduled times. They are not recorded.</li> <li>• <b>In-person, online scheduled, and online asynchronous:</b> In-person and online class meetings are held synchronously at regularly scheduled times, and students may also participate in the class asynchronously online, with recordings and other instructor-produced activities.</li> </ul> <p>The combination of in-person and online instructional components meets the established equivalent for the credit hours designated.</p> <p>In all cases, students can alternate between the options available for the class throughout the quarter.</p> <p>All classes are supported through use of the College's Learning Management System.</p>	\$25	<p><b>FL1 In-person and online asynchronous:</b> "Students can (1) attend classes on campus or (2) complete the class entirely online with regular due dates. Students may switch between these 2 modes throughout the term; there is no Zoom option. Reliable internet access required. You must log into Canvas by the first day of the quarter to get started. See schedule for class meeting days/times/location."</p> <p><b>FL2 In-person and online scheduled:</b> "Students can (1) attend scheduled classes on campus or (2) attend through Zoom; attendance expected. Students may switch between these 2 modes throughout the term; there is no asynchronous online option. Reliable internet access required. You must log into Canvas by the first day of the quarter to get started. See schedule for class meeting days/times/location."</p> <p><b>FL3 In-person, online scheduled, and online asynchronous:</b> "Students can (1) attend scheduled classes on campus, (2) attend classes through Zoom, or (3) participate entirely online with regular due dates. Students may switch between these 3 modes throughout the term. Reliable internet access required. You must log into Canvas by the first day of the quarter to get started. See schedule for class meeting days/times/location."</p>
		<p><b>EXAMPLES:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ MoTuThFr class on campus with 100% async permitted but no Zoom option; uses <b>In-person and online asynchronous (FL1)</b> class note.</li> <li>✓ Class is held on campus two days/times per week and students join in person or on Zoom with remainder of instruction online; uses <b>In-person and online scheduled (FL2)</b> class note</li> <li>✓ Class is held on campus at specified days/times with Zoom attendance and 100% asynchronous participation permitted; uses <b>In-person, online scheduled, and online asynchronous (FL3)</b> class note.</li> </ul>			

OS	Online Scheduled	<p>An online class where instruction takes place synchronously (virtual meetings held at specific days and times noted in the class schedule) using internet/web-based tools.</p> <p>The class may include activities held asynchronously (without a set time to attend).</p> <p>Remote proctored exams are an allowable activity for this instruction mode.</p>	<p>Online classes that are <b>scheduled</b>. Sessions require students to interact with each other, the faculty, and content at specific times.</p> <p>The combination of scheduled sessions and online instructional components meets the established equivalent for the credit hours designated.</p> <p>Remote proctored exams still allow for this classification.</p> <p>All online classes are supported through use of the College's Learning Management System.</p>	\$25	<p>"This class is online with scheduled meetings and requires Canvas. You must log into Canvas by the first day of the quarter to get started. See schedule for class meeting days/times."</p>
		<p><b>EXAMPLES:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Online with scheduled Zoom meetings two days per week</li> </ul>			
OA	Online Asynchronous	<p>A class in which all required instruction occurs online asynchronously (without a set time to attend but within a specified time frame) using web-based tools.</p> <p>There are no required real-time (synchronous) class meetings; however, the instructor may choose to offer optional office hours and other activities where attendance is not required.</p> <p>Remote proctored exams are an allowable activity for this classification.</p>	<p>Online classes that are <b>unscheduled</b>. Sessions are not held at specific times, but learning is structured to take place over the duration of the class and is not self-paced.</p> <p>The online instructional components meet the established equivalent for the credit hours designated.</p> <p>All online classes are supported through use of the College's Learning Management System.</p>	\$25	<p>"This class is fully online without scheduled meetings and requires Canvas. You must log into Canvas by the first day of the quarter to get started."</p>
		<p><b>EXAMPLES:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Online class with no set times to attend.</li> </ul>
