Teacher Course Assurances

2023-24

The annual assurance process provides high schools and Walla Walla Community College the opportunity to identify and agree upon instructor responsibilities and expectations for teaching courses approved for CTE Dual Credit. In addition, providing copies of instructor certifications provides evidence of professional expertise and content knowledge for college-level rigor and curriculum.

- 1. High school instructors teaching courses designated for CTE Dual Credit will teach the competencies or curriculum prescribed by the signed articulation agreement.
- 2. High school instructors and college instructors will meet as necessary or requested to review and align their respective courses and curriculum competencies. They will specify in which secondary courses students may earn college-equivalent credit or meet college competencies.
- 3. High school instructors teaching courses designated for CTE Dual Credit will only award credit to those students who have achieved those competencies outlined in the signed articulation agreement.
- 4. High school instructors and career counselors/specialists will support students in the registration process for CTE Dual Credit using the web-based online registration system at https://www.ctesers.org.
- 5. High school instructors will inform students their participation in the CTE Dual Credit program is voluntary. High school students registered in the Student Enrollment Reporting System (SERS) for CTE Dual Credit will follow WWCC student policies for transcription of credit. Credit and/or grades will not be removed once they have been transcribed.
- 6. High school instructors will inform students of, and adhere to the following CTE Dual Credit deadlines for the 2022-23 academic year:

Last day for students to register in SERS: May 1st, 2024 Instructor grades due online:

- June 30, 2024
- 7. WWCC will accept agreed upon CTE Dual Credits from eligible students coming from consortium high schools and grades will only be transcribed upon student request.
- 8. High school instructors and career counselors/specialists along with WWCC will inform students of CTE Dual Credit options available to them.
- 9. High School Instructors will attach copies of teaching certificate form if they have not done so before.
