

2025-2026: Touchet High School Graduation Requirements & WWCC College Equivalencies

This guide helps students and families understand how high school graduation requirements align with Walla Walla Community College (WWCC) courses. Requirements and equivalencies are subject to change based on the WWCC course catalog and WA state high school graduation requirements.

High School Requirement	College Equivalent (WWCC)
Junior English (1.0 HS credit = 5 WWCC credits)	ENG&101 or ENG&102, or a Lit course (see advisor and counselor)
Senior English (1.0 HS credit = 5 WWCC credits)	ENG&101 or ENG&102, or a Lit course (see advisor and counselor)
U.S. History (1.0 HS credit = 5 WWCC credits)	HIST&146 OR HIST&147 OR HIST&149
Am. Govt. (.5 HS credit or 3 WWCC credits) *(.5 credit = Am. Govt & .5 credit = CWP)*	POLS&202
CWP (1.0 HS credit = 5 WWCC credits)	POLS&202
Quantitative Math or science (senior year)	any college-level math, chemistry, or physics
CTE/Oc. Ed	any Criminal Justice, Business, Computer Science, or Prof/Tech
Health (.5 HS = 3 WWCC credits)	TBD by high school
PE (Five 1-credit PE = 1.0 HS credit or Three 1-credit PE = 0.5 HS credit)	any "active" PE or DANCE; see advisor
Fine Art	any music, drama, art, or dance
Science (w/lab)	Astronomy, Chemistry, Biology, Oceanography, Geology, Physics
