This guide helps students and families understand how high school graduation requirements align with Walla Walla Community College (WWCC) courses. Requirements and equivalencies are subject to change based on the WWCC course catalog and WA state high school graduation requirements.

Quantitative Math/Science (senior year)	Any college-level Math, Chemistry, or Physics
CTE / Occupational Education	Any Criminal Justice, Business, Computer Science, or Prof/Tech
Health (.5 HS = 3 credits)	HPER 264: Stress Mgmt, HPER 274: Pers & Comm Health
PE (5 WWCC credit = 1.0 HS or 3 WWCC credit = 0.5 HS)	Any 'active' PE or Dance; see advisor
Fine Art	Any performance Music, Drama, Art, or Dance
Science (with lab)	Astronomy, Chemistry, Biology, Oceanography, Geology, Physics
